

## Angela Dunn, model

"I tend to go completely bare-faced or wear full make-up, but I never wear a lot of foundation, I prefer to let my freckles show through. Nor do I pencil in my brows, I hate seeing drawn-in lines, I tint them instead. It's fun to experiment, but most of the tricks I have learnt have come from make-up artists I've worked with. I love the Fifties eyeliner flick, but would love to master a subtle eyeliner look."

**Fiona's bag analysis:** "Angela knows her stuff. She's experimental with colours and has the tools of the trade in her kit – tweezers, brushes and eyelash curlers. She also has eye drops – dabbed on pimples they remove redness, making them easy to cover."  
**"I'd like to apply eyeliner without it looking over-the-top..."**

"Apply a pencil liner finely along the lid and smudge with the fingers to break up the bold line. By brushing a similar shade of eyeshadow over the liner you soften the edges but give definition to the eye. With dark colours, it's best to apply with one brush and blend with another so you're

not loading up the colour. I chose Colour Focus Eyeshadow in L'ombre de la Luce, by Lancôme [£10.50; nationwide]. Concentrate dark colours on the outer corner of the eye – bringing dark shadows too far into the inner corner draws the eyes together. To add to the illusion of distance, I blended a light shimmer on the sides of the nose at eye level. I also ran a little black eyeliner on the inner rim – it really makes light green and blue eyes like Angela's shimmer. I suggested she try Juicy Tube in Raisin by Lancôme [£11] on her lips as she likes lipsticks that leave a slight stain and this gives a glossy hint of colour." ■

From indigo to violet, it was the main focus of autumn make-up collections. Fiona Jolly recommends that 'paler skin should try lighter, brighter shades of lilac or pinky purples. Darker skins suit deep indigos.' If you're colour shy, start with a dark colour on your nails.
